Some After investigating the various methods of raising queens, the Nicot Box & Cloake Board method was selected for my queen rearing activities. The Doolittle Method(G.M. Doolittle) is to graft the appropriate aged larvae into some homemade wax cups. This requires a bit of dexterity and good eyesight, but is the most popular method used.

The Cloake board is named after the New Zealand beekeeper, Harry Cloake, who developed the board and the method. With the use of a Cloake board, one can raise queens from one colony with minimal hive manipulations. The Cloake board is simply an excluder encased in a three sided shim that acts as a entrance.

The Cloake method of queen rearing involves a series of stages which divide a colony into a queenright lower colony and a queenless upper colony to improve acceptance of grafted larva, or to facilitate the creation of queen cells

The premise behind the Cloake Board method of queen rearing is to simulate queenlessness in the hive so that, when the grafted queen cells are introduced to the hive the bees will immediately work to care for and raise the new queens. This stimulus method was created by New Zealand's Harry Cloake.

Prime Bees: Queen Rearing – Cloake Board

A Cloake board, or floor without a floor, is a special piece of equipment used in beekeeping to facilitate raising queen bees. Invented by Harry Cloake, the Cloake board consists of a queen excluder mounted to a wooden frame. The wooden frame contains a slot which allows a “temporary” floor (solid divider) to be inserted.

The Cloake board method lets you raise high-quality queens by using a single hive as your donor, cell starter and cell finisher.

A Cloake board (Floor Without a Floor) is a useful method. You can rearrange things so that part of the hive is queenless during the starter period and queenright as a finisher without a lot of disruption of the hive. But it's not necessary.

The Cloake board method works great. And, you don't have to manufacture a cloake board. I use a piece of cardboard. Slip it in between the two boxes for the 2-3 days as they start the queen cells. Remove it and lay it in front of the hive to keep weeds down. You don't even have to lift the box to remove the cardboard.
